Drama School Policies

PAYMENTS Payment is due upon registration. Registration is not guaranteed until payment has been received.

REFUNDS There are no refunds for withdrawals that happen 1 week or less prior to the class starting.

BEFORE AND AFTER CLASS Carousel Theatre for Young People and our instructors are not responsible for students before or after class time. A \$10 fee is charged for all late pick-ups. Please note early drop-offs are not permitted.

AGE Students must be registered in the classes that correspond with their age. There are no exceptions.

ABSENTEEISM Please call Carousel Theatre for Young People in advance if your child will be absent from a class. Absenteeism can be very disruptive, so please ensure your child does not miss more than two classes. If your child misses two or more classes their role in the Open House demonstration may be limited.

LATENESS Please ensure your child arrives on time for class. We respectfully request that you do not send your child to class if he or she will be more than 10 minutes late.

GUESTS IN CLASS For the comfort of our students and instructors, parents/guardians are not permitted to observe classes and are asked to wait in the lobby—or go and enjoy Granville Island!

MINIMUM ENROLLMENT We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment. In the event of a cancellation, a full refund will be provided.

BULLYING Carousel Drama School has ZERO tolerance for bullying of any kind. Such behavior can result in the automatic cancellation of a registration.

DRESS CODE Please ensure your child is wearing comfortable clothing. If they are wearing a dress or skirt ensure there are leggings underneath. If it is a rainy day please ensure you bring inside shoes - there are no bare or stocking feet allowed for safety reasons.
